#### Flu Immunisations

We would like to remind you that flu immunisations for all children (Reception through to Year 6) will be taking place in school on Thursday 2nd October.

The flu vaccine is a quick and painless nasal spray that helps protect your child—and others around them—from the flu virus. It's especially important as we head into the colder months when flu can spread more easily. What you need to do:
