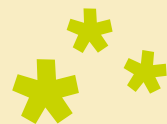
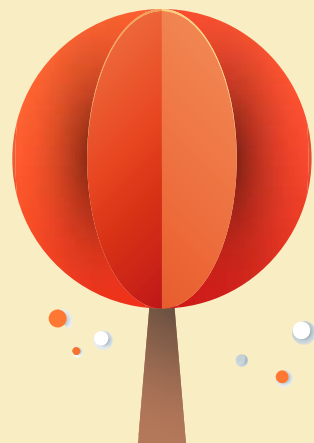

Children's literacy skills will be developed through key stories each week.

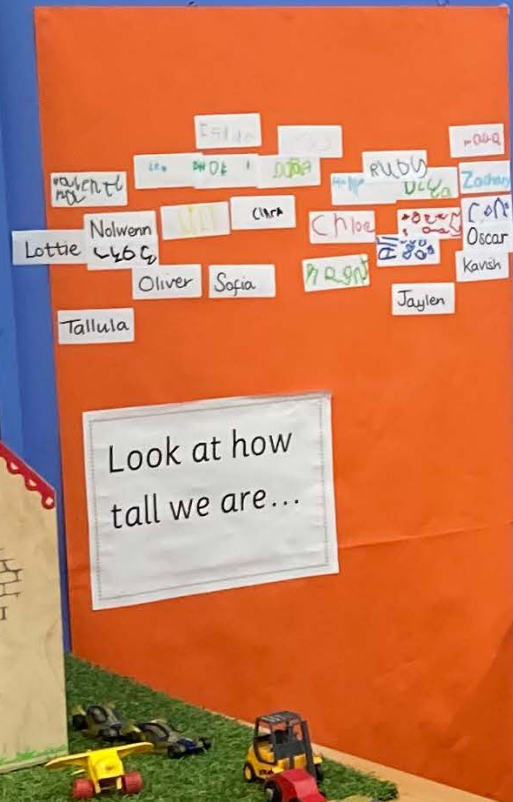
Mathematical skills are developed through exploration and practical activities.
