Online Safety - Be Scam Smart

We have been sent the link above by Internet Matters to share with parents. Neurodivergent children are at greater risk of falling victim to scams, but the information on the page and in the guide is useful for all parents to consider, particularly as children may get new devices over Christmas.

ROBLOX

Earlier this year, the Online Safety Act was introduced to help make the internet safer for everyone. As technology has advanced, it's become easier for anyone to access almost any content online—and that brings real risks. Adults face scams and hacking attempts, while children can be exposed to strangers and harmful content.

One area of concern has been online games, where children often chat and play with others. These spaces can lack proper checks, making it easier for predators to target young players.

Roblox, a popular platform for children, is now adding new safety features. These include facial analysis to confirm age and optional ID checks for users over 13. These steps are designed to make sure players are who they say they are and to reduce the chances of unsafe interactions. It's a big move towards creating a safer online environment and follows the rules set out in the Online Safety Act




